Michael Lee Kinnamon, 69, of Milton, Iowa went to be with his Lord on April 14, 2019 at Mercy Medical Center in Des Moines. He was born June 7, 1949 in Ottumwa, Iowa to Jack Laverne and Faith Elnora Adams Kinnamon. He has lived on the family farm since he was two years old and was very proud of that. On August 30, 1969 he married Linda Dabney in Savannah, Iowa. The couple had three children; Stacie, Joshua, and Wesley.

Mike worked at John Deere for 30 years, retiring in 2002. He was also a farmer raising cattle, crops, running a custom hay business, and training horses. He was an active member of the Milton Christian Church and served on the board of the IMO Christian Camp. Every year he would take camp kids to the National Youth Roundup in Colorado. It was a trip he loved and looked forward to. He will be missed by his family, friends, and church family very much.
