PULASKI: Albert Eugene Grim, 85, of Pulaski, Iowa died April 24, 2008 at his home. He was born April 3, 1923 in Davis County, Iowa to Albert and Elizabeth Brown Grim. He married Martha E. Hargrove July 29, 1944 in Kileen, Texas while being stationed at Fort Hood Army Training Base. She precedes him in death November 12, 2003. Known to his family and friends as "Gene", he grew up in rural Davis County and Van Buren Counties. He graduated from Pulaski High School and joined the United States Army. During WWII he served in Italy. After the war, he moved to his current residence south of Pulaski. Gene was very conservation minded as he was one of the first in the county to build erosion control terraces. He prided himself on his skill as a farmer and enjoyed being a short line machinery dealer. He is survived by 3 sons, Donald E. He is preceded in death by his wife; parents; and 2 sisters, Jane White and Ann Cone. Funeral services will be at 2 pm Monday, April 28, 2008 at the Grace United Methodist Church in Milton, Iowa with Pastor Bryon Wixom officiating.
