



## Beulah Stockham

January 15, 1919 - August 10, 2015

Beulah Lorine Stockham, 96, of rural Bloomfield, Iowa passed away August 10, 2015 at the Ottumwa Hospice House. She was born January 15, 1919 south of Savannah, Iowa in Wyaconda Township to Clem and Carrie Martin York. She married Gene Stockham February 20, 1937 in Lancaster, Missouri.
