Beverly Ann Woolard, 90, of Bloomfield, Iowa passed away on February 5, 2023 at the Ottumwa Regional Medical Center in Ottumwa, Iowa. She was born on the family farm in Davis County, Iowa on October 11, 1932 to George and Pearl Moughler Gregerson. She married Jack Woolard on October 2, 1953 at the Bloomfield Christian Church.

Beverly attended Oak Hill and Howell (Red Brush) country schools, graduated from Lancaster High School and then Northeast Missouri State Teachers College. She taught school for 37 years, mostly at Davis County. After her retirement from teaching, Beverly and Jack established Memory Lane Antique Mall and Bass'n Man Tackle Shop in Bloomfield. Beverly was an active volunteer for many years for the Davis County Tourism Corporation and the Davis County Welcome Center. Some of her hobbies included; collecting antiques, painting pictures, quilting, playing cards with her friends and neighbors, and enjoying beautiful flowers. Beverly was a member of the Bloomfield Christian Church.

She is survived by her husband, Jack; sister-in-law, Janet Woolard of Bloomfield; nephew, Brad (Kristi) Woolard of Bloomfield; and a great-nephew, Nathan Woolard of Winter Garden, Florida.

She was preceded in death by her parents; six-year-old sister, Florence Marie

Gregerson; and brother-in-law, Joe Woolard.

Graveside services will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Monday, February 13, 2023 at the IOOF Cemetery in Bloomfield with close family friend Steve Augspurger officiating. No visitation is planned.
