January 17, 1923 - January 8, 2015

Marion Earl “Breezy” Roberts, 91, of Oskaloosa, Iowa and former resident of Bloomfield, Iowa died January 8, 2015 at the Hospice Serenity House in Oskaloosa. He was born January 17, 1923 in Bloomfield to Marion E. and Lizzie Mustard Roberts. He married Enid Roberta Langford May 29, 1946 in Floris, Iowa.
