She also was very organized and kept the farm running on well-oiled wheels. She had an amazing talent at encouraging each family member's special abilities and bringing them together to make a team. Another talent she had was making each person she knew feel like they were important and loved. She loved music and singing while she worked. She appreciated beauty in nature and continually shared what she noticed with those around her; a pretty leaf, the sunset, baby foxes, a bright rock, a blue heron, an animal track, a rainbow. She loved flowers and flowering weeds. She hated mornings!
