Clarence Dale Bogle, 82, of rural Bloomfield, Iowa passed away on November 11, 2020 at Harry S. Truman Memorial Veterans' Hospital in Columbia, Missouri. 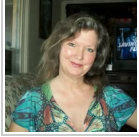
