Carl Dean Van Horn, 81, of Bloomfield, Iowa died May 7, 2014 at the Davis County Hospital in Bloomfield. He was born May 8, 1932 in Davis County to Lester Deo and Georgia Helen Francis Van Horn. He married Joan Porter November 26, 1950 in Bloomfield. Carl was educated in the Davis County Schools and graduated from Emily Griffith Opportunity School in Denver, Colorado. After serving in the United States Army for two years he was involved in farming with his father. In 1957 he moved to Denver, Colorado where he worked with ServiceMaster for several years before spending the majority of his working years as a technician for Sears Roebuck Company, retiring in 1990. He lived in Colorado for 13 years and lived in Nebraska for 25 years. He returned to Bloomfield when he retired. Carl was a member of Christian Churches at his various places of residence and served as an Elder for several years.

He is survived by his wife; daughter, Julie (David) Boening of Lakewood, Colorado; son, Dean (Ruth) Van Horn of Hugoton, Kansas; grandson Phillip Van Horn of Wichita, Kansas; and two nephews, Larry Van Horn of Springfield, Virginia, Danny Van Horn of Bloomfield.

He was preceded in death by his parents; a brother, Bob Van Horn; and a sister-in-law, Esther Van Horn.

Funeral services will be at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 10, 2014 at the Wagler Funeral Home in Bloomfield with Pastor Jack Knox officiating. Burial with graveside military rites performed by Reed-Whisler Post #78 of the American Legion will be at the IOOF Cemetery in Bloomfield. Visitation will begin at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday with the family present to greet friends from 1:00 p.m. until the time of the service.
