Charlotte Jeanne Goeken, 95, of Bloomfield, Iowa passed away on February 4, 2022 at Vista Woods Care Center in Ottumwa, Iowa. She was born on March 25, 1926 in McLean, Illinois to Elmer and Alice Noble Lucas. She grew up in the Delavan, Illinois area and graduated from Delavan High School.
