Christopher James Feldmann, 41, of Bloomfield, Iowa passed away on February 6, 2018. He was born on August 7, 1976 to Robert Feldmann and Linda Mae Kenny Wiley in Dubuque, Iowa. Chris graduated from Maquoketa Valley High School in 1995 and attended Indian Hills Community College where he earned an Associate's Degree in Auto Body Collision. 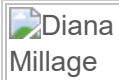

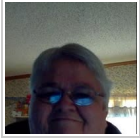

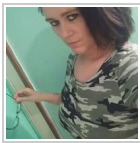
