BLOOMFIELD: Dillon Lyons, 93, of Coralville, Iowa and former resident of Bloomfield, Iowa died December 16, 2013 at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics in Iowa City. He was born August 4, 1920 in Bloomfield to Howard William and Estella Belle Francis Lyons. He married Mary Lee Chadwick November 24, 1940 in Bloomfield. She preceded him in death June 27, 2006. Dillon served in the United States Navy during World War II. He was a farmer and worked at John Morrell in Ottumwa. He was a member of the Bloomfield Christian Church and Reed-Whisler Post #78 of the American Legion in Bloomfield. He had also been a member of the Good Sam's Club and the Kalico Klickers.
