September 4, 1937 - March 9, 2015

After a protracted battle with cancer, Dixie Lea von Feldt died on March 9th, 2015 in Pulaski, Iowa at the age of 77. She leaves behind her husband, James R. and her sons, Michael and Scott, grandsons Kevin and Peter von Feldt and granddaughter Megan von Feldt.
