Donna Mae Blumhagen, 85, of Bloomfield, Iowa passed away on June 5, 2025 at Centerville Specialty Care in Centerville, Iowa. She was born on August 13, 1939 in Decorah, Iowa to Raymond B. and Julitta Christine Kleve Bushman. She married Dale Blumhagen on August 5, 1958 in Festina, Iowa. The couple had a dairy farm in northeast Iowa and later south of Pulaski, Iowa for many years. They raised six children and enjoyed 52 years of marriage before divorce.

Donna graduated from cosmetology school in 1982 and worked as a cosmetologist for 40 years; most of her career was spent as owner of Cutter's Lane on the Bloomfield Square. Spending time with family was important to her and part of that time was spent dancing to her favorite country band "Blue Majic" which consisted of four of her six children, traveling with them to their many musical gigs. Donna loved music, playing her accordion at nursing homes, and

showing her competitive side, joined a women's bowling league. In her younger years, she played softball, and eventually learned to play the guitar. She will be greatly missed by her family and friends.
