Dorothy Joann Hopkins, 83, of Bloomfield, Iowa passed away on May 2, 2021, at the Davis County Hospital surrounded by family. She was born on May 1, 1938, to John Copley and Irma Ruth (Lucas) Sager at the family home in Bloomfield. She graduated from Bloomfield High School in 1955 and married Russell Dean Hopkins on April 30, 1955. Russell passed away on May 28, 2020.

Dorothy was very active in any community that she lived. In Bloomfield, she was a lifelong member of the Bloomfield United Methodist Church and United Methodist Women.
