Gary Wayne Russell, 62, of rural Bloomfield, Iowa passed away on October 17, 2021 at his home. He was born on July 6, 1959 in Oskaloosa, Iowa to Robert George and E. Irene Belzer Russell. Gary's family moved to Davis County when he was only two years old and he graduated from Davis County High School in 1977. He married Mary Mincks in August of 1985, and they were later divorced. Outside of working on a cattle ranch for a couple years, Gary lived his entire adult life in Davis County.
