George Stuart “Stu” Lynch, 86, of rural Bloomfield, Iowa passed away June 30, 2016 at the Bloomfield Care Center. He was born on February 7, 1930 in Moulton, Iowa to George Daniel and Alberta V. 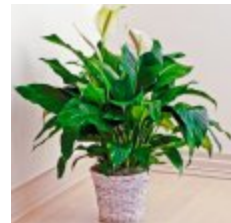
