



Gordon Appenzeller

September 24, 1931 - May 23, 2014

Gordon Dean Appenzeller, 82, passed away peacefully at his home in rural Bloomfield, Iowa early May 23, 2014. Gordon was born in the family home in Granger, Iowa on September 24, 1931 to Elmer and Hazel Gordon Appenzeller. He graduated from Stratford High School in Stratford, Iowa. He was a lifelong farmer and worked as a union carpenter in Des Moines for several years while farming. He moved his family to a farm near Floris, Iowa in 1964 and remained there until his death. Gordon's greatest joy was managing his livestock and breeding and showing his cutting horses.
