Hal Owen "H.O." Moore, 53, of Bloomfield, Iowa passed away March 21, 2016 at the Keosauqua Health Center in Keosauqua, Iowa. He was born December 3, 1962 in Davis County, Iowa to Dwight Owen and Ginger Topaz Mustard Moore. H.O. graduated from Fox Valley High School and joined the Army Reserves, serving for 6 years. After graduating from the Indian Hills Aviation Mechanic Program, he moved to Parsippany, New Jersey where he worked in railroad construction for ten years. After moving back to Iowa, he worked at Barker Wire and drove a milk truck. In his spare time, H.O. enjoyed hunting, fishing, woodworking, and spending time with his nieces and nephews.
