Hazel Cruikshank Brown, 90, of Bloomfield, Iowa passed away on December 6, 2020 at the Bloomfield Care Center. She was born May 3, 1930 in Davis County, Iowa to Guy and Nellie Piper Hill. She graduated from Bloomfield High School in 1947. She married Harold Lee Cruikshank on April 3, 1948 in Bloomfield. They lived on a farm south of Bloomfield until Harold's death on June 27, 1983. On October 5, 1985, she married Lawrence T. Brown and moved to the Packwood, Iowa area. He passed away on November 3, 2008.

Hazel was a member of the Bloomfield Christian Church, Davis County Genealogy Society, life member of the American Legion Auxiliary Post 504 of Richland, Iowa, life member of the Davis County Sheep Producers, life member of the Disabled American Veterans Auxiliary, and a member of the Davis County Guerilla Raid Society.
