J. Dean Baughman, 85, of Shawnee, Kansas and former resident of Bloomfield, Iowa passed away Saturday, August 1, 2015. He was born November 19, 1929 in Pulaski, Iowa to W.W. "Pete" and Velma Blasi Baughman. He graduated from Pulaski High School in 1947. J. Dean married Donna Joan Bailey November 11, 1961 in Monroe, Iowa. The couple lived in Bloomfield until retiring to Florida in 1999. They lived in Florida until moving to Kansas earlier this year.

While living in Bloomfield, J. Dean was an independent insurance agent with his father starting in the 1950's. He then owned Baughman Insurance Service from 1979 until he sold the business to North Side of the Square, Inc in 1988. He then became a Management Consultant for North Side and was a board member for North Side of the Square, Inc and also the Davis County Savings Bank. He was a member of the Mariner United Methodist Church in Brooksville, Florida.

J. Dean is survived by his wife, Donna Joan Baughman of Shawnee; son, Jerry Dean (Brad Lentz) Baughman of Iowa City; daughter, Teresa (Mark) Hargrave of Lenexa, Kansas; two grandchildren, Heather (Matthew) Lange of Kansas City, Missouri, Dylan Hargrave of Lawrence, Kansas; and a sister, Norma Jean Wheaton of Ottumwa, Iowa.

He was preceded in death by his parents and two brothers, William and Keith Baughman.
