Jason Boyd Proctor, 49, of Omaha, Nebraska, passed away on March 13, 2023, at the University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha. As an organ donor, he gave the greatest gift of all - life to strangers. He was born on November 16, 1973, in Centerville, Iowa, to Dennis and Nancy Parks Proctor. He graduated from Prairie High School in Cedar Rapids and then attended the University of Iowa, graduating in 1997. He loved wrestling from peewee days in Corydon, Iowa, where he grew up, to his very successful high school wrestling career at Prairie. He went on to wrestle for the Iowa Hawkeyes for one year. On June 12, 2004, he married Jennifer Jones in Lampe, Missouri. From this union, the sunshine of his life, Hannah Jane, was born. She has always been the light of his life and will be forever. Jason and Jennifer were later divorced.

After college, Jason moved to Omaha and worked for Bank of the West for 25 years. He loved participating in any kind of sport--wrestling, golf, tennis, or pickleball to name a few. He was an avid Iowa Hawkeye fan. Jason was one of a kind--so smart, so handsome, so funny, so kind, and he knew how to push the envelope...stinker. He lived life to extremes. He did nothing part-way. He loved hard, worked hard, lived hard. His life will be remembered and celebrated for years to come by all those who loved him.

He is survived by his daughter, Hannah Jane Proctor of Omaha; parents,

Dennis and Nancy Proctor of Bloomfield, Iowa; sister, Haley (Pat) Zamastil of Fairfax, Iowa; nephew, Holden Zamastil; niece, Piper Zamastil; and many aunts, uncles, and cousins who loved him for who he was.
