Jerald Dean Jackson, 72, of Floris, Iowa died October 21, 2014 at the Ottumwa Regional Health Center due to injuries suffered in a car accident. He was born July 16, 1942 in Davis County to Lowell and Irene Humphrey Jackson. He married Echo Pauline Cassill December 27, 1963 in Davis County. She preceded him in death July 28, 1987. Jerald was a lifelong farmer near Floris in Davis County. His farm was recognized as a Heritage Farm in 2011. He worked many agricultural related jobs during his lifetime from his days on the wheat harvest as a young man to driving trucks in his later years. Jerald was employed by the Davis County Community School District in the bus garage and as a school bus driver. Jerald served on the Davis County Community School Board throughout the seventies and early eighties. He also served as a Davis County Supervisor. He was a longtime member of Bethlehem Christian Church where he served in many capacities. For many years he has attended Living Hope Bible Church in Eldon.

Jerald is survived by three sons, Rodney (Julie) Jackson of Somerset, Virginia, Brian Jackson of Unionville, Iowa, Brent (Rebekah) Jackson of Stockton, Missouri; six grandchildren, Dustin, Leremy, Luke, Faith, Levi and Titus Jackson; one brother, Carl Jackson of Johnston, Iowa; one sister, Susan Jackson of Ottumwa, Iowa; and his mother-in-law Irene Cassill Thompson of Ottumwa.

He was preceded in death by his parents; wife; and infant sister, Sheril Jean Jackson.

Funeral services will be at 10:30 a.m. on Friday, October 24, 2014 at the Wagler Funeral Home in Bloomfield with Pastors Dave Albert and Jack Jackson officiating. Burial will be at the Mt. Gilead Cemetery near Floris, Iowa. Visitation will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday with the family present to greet friends from 5-7:00 p.m. at the funeral home.
