Larry Dean Oaks, 82, of Bloomfield, Iowa passed away on April 29, 2022 at the Bloomfield Care Center. He was born on July 25, 1939 in Milton, Iowa to John Rocky and Grethel Twila Sheets Oaks. He graduated from Milton High School in 1957. Larry married Connie Judd in October of 1967 in Milton.
