Leo Carrol Ornduff, 87, of Troy, Iowa passed away on November 18, 2023 at the Bloomfield Care Center. He was born on August 10, 1936 in Troy, Iowa to Guy Wallace and Ve Irene McLeland Ornduff. He graduated from Troy High School in 1954 where he participated in baseball and basketball. Leo joined the Army and served in Germany during the Korean War. On February 21, 1960, he married Ila Joan Stigers.

Leo was a farmer and worked for Troy Elevator and Mid-States Manufacturing in Milton until his retirement. He also worked as a farmhand for many years. Leo was active in harness racing as a driver and then as a trainer. He spent many summer days going from one county fair to another to harness race, announce races, and be a race official. Leo was a member of the Troy United Methodist Church, Troy Card Club, Southeast Iowa Harness Racing Association, and the US Trotting Association. He enjoyed golfing, watching the St. Louis Cardinals, and listening to Alan Jackson, George Jones, and Johnny Cash.
