Lois Elaine Eakins passed away on May 23, 2026, at MercyOne Des Moines Medical Center surrounded by her family.

She was born on January 14, 1942, and welcomed into the open arms of her parents Walter and Mildred Martin Riedel. Lois grew up on a farm alongside sister Carol and enjoyed playing with her cats and dolls. She attended school in Bloomfield where she played a clarinet in the band. After graduating high school, she completed nursing school in Des Moines. She worked at the Davis County Hospital, during which she met her future husband.

Lois married Harry Dean Eakins on August 4, 1963. They had three children – Nolan, Sharry, and Brenda. Although she enjoyed being a nurse, she understood the demands of marrying a farmer. Naturally, she loved Thanksgiving where all her favorite people were gathered around one table to enjoy the feast she had prepared.

Her favorite trips included: Sequoia National Park, Disneyland, driving through New England, and especially the buzz of New York City. She was so proud of her family and her only wish in life was for us to be happy. With her, we always were, and with her memory, we always will be.
