Lois and husband Lee owned and operated the Pony Farm in Bloomfield and she later worked for the Davis County Savings Bank, retiring in 1986. She was a member of the Bloomfield United Methodist Church, a 50 year member and past matron of Bloomfield Friendship Chapter 46 of the Order of Eastern Star, Bloomfield Chapter "Q" and past state president of Iowa TTT, and the P.E.O. Chapter "B." She was also a member of the Friday Club and was a Rainbow mother. She is survived by a step-daughter, Nancy Swope of Ottumwa, Iowa; a step-son, Hal Schmitter of Middleburg, Vermont; four step-grandchildren; two nieces, Pam Brake of Bloomfield, Patricia St. Clair of Phoenix, Arizona; a nephew, Bob Hull of Bloomfield; and several great-nieces and nephews.
