like. Later in life she took up oil painting & made special paintings for each of her children.

Marjorie was a devoted & proud life-long fan of the St. Louis Cardinals baseball team. She seldom missed a televised game & even got to attend one in person some years ago which she thoroughly enjoyed. She also enjoyed league bowling with her husband and in later years with her daughters. Many fun state bowling tournament trips were taken over the years.

Marjorie is survived by six children: Richard (Deb), Donna, David (Shonda), Mark (Rena), Laura Rickelman (Steve) & John (Penny). There are too many grandchildren & great-grandchildren to count, but not too many to love. Preceding her in death were brothers Vernon & Roger. She will be forever remembered & loved by them all.

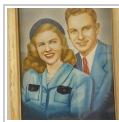

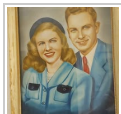

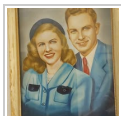
