BLOOMFIELD: Max Ernest Silvers, 82, of Bloomfield, Iowa died September 18, 2013 at his home. He was born October 19, 1930 in West Grove, Iowa to Claire Ernest and Helen Mae Kinman Silvers. He married Margaret Ann Gooden March 6, 1954 in the Little Brown Church in Nashua, Iowa. Max served in the United States Army during the Korean War. He was a farmer and worked for John Deere for over 30 years, retiring in 1993 as the Head Field Mechanic. After retirement he started a hay baling business which kept him busy until his late 70's. He was a member of the West Grove United Methodist Church, Reed-Whisler Post #78 of the American Legion in Bloomfield, the UAW Local 74 in Ottumwa, and was active in helping disabled veterans. Max enjoyed showing antique cars and tractors at shows for many years. He also enjoyed car races and spent time racing midgets in his younger days. He was a life-long resident of Bloomfield.
