Hazel Maxine Taylor, 94, of Bloomfield, died at 9:46 a.m. March 2, 2014, at Davis County Hospital in Bloomfield. She was born April 3, 1919, in rural Davis County to Charles Grant and Lora Mae Walker Stevenson. She married Ralph Parker Taylor on June 15, 1938, in Ottumwa. Maxine was a member of the Bloomfield Christian Church. She and her husband farmed for almost 40 years before retiring and moving to Bloomfield. They spent many winters in Arizona after retiring. She had also worked in the laundry department at the Davis County Hospital. She enjoyed crocheting, quilting, and reading. She was an excellent cook and loved tending to her flowers. She won the Spiffy award in 2013.
