Nancy St Clair, 77, of Des Moines, Iowa and former resident of Bloomfield, Iowa passed away on March 22, 2025 at the Kavanaugh House in Des Moines. She graduated from Davis County High School in 1966, and attended Indian Hills Community College, graduating with an Associate of Arts degree in nursing. 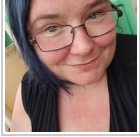
