



## Newt Clendenen

December 6, 1921 - December 11, 2014

Irvin Warren "Newt" Clendenen, 93, of Milton, Iowa died December 10, 2014 at Mercy Medical Center in Des Moines. He was born December 6, 1921 in Davis County, Iowa to Dale and Elsie Christy Clendenen. He married Wilberta Oliver August 6, 1944 in Yuma, Arizona. He served in the Army Air Forces during WWII. He was a farmer and raised Angus cattle as well as other livestock. Newt was a member of Russell-Strait Post #483 of the Milton American Legion, the Milton United Methodist Church, and former member of the Milton Lions Club. He had a love for baseball and coached Little League for several years. In his spare time, he enjoyed hunting, fishing, and camping.
