Ramona Nina Schooley, 63, of Bloomfield, Iowa passed away January 3, 2016 at St. Mary's Hospital in Rochester, Minnesota. 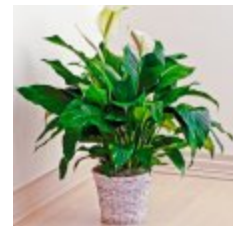

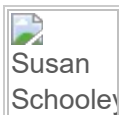
