Raymond Michale Nally, 80, of rural Bloomfield, Iowa passed away on May 11, 2022 at the Bloomfield Care Center. He was born on August 15, 1941 in Kansas City, Kansas to John and Julia Spillane Nally. He served in the Air Force for five years and was proud of his service time.

Ray worked as a beer salesman for several years before working for the postal service at the bulk mail sorting center in Kansas City. He is survived by a son, Grady (Wendy) Stevens of Bloomfield; six grandchildren, Andrew, Tony, Jessica, Emily, Paige, Jeffrey; three great-grandchildren, Shelby, Carter, Marina; brother, Joseph Nally of Kansas City, Kansas; and several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents; two brothers, John and Bernard

Nally; and a sister, Mary Catherine Nally.

Ray's wish was to be cremated. A Celebration of Life Service will be held at a later date.
