Harold Rex Wintermote, 79, of Bloomfield, Iowa passed away February 20, 2015 at his home. He was born August 30, 1935 in Davis County to Guy and Eva Elkins Wintermote. He graduated from Bloomfield High School in 1952 and went to work for Ray Whitacre. In 1955 he married Lois Parker at the Bloomfield Christian Church. He later worked as a butcher and manager for Benner Food Store, Jack and Jill Grocery store, Coast to Coast Store in Bloomfield, traveled for Haw Hardware, owned Carroll Hardware and built houses.
