Charles Leroy “Roy” Hunt, 97, of Bloomfield, Iowa died July 20, 2014 at the Bloomfield Care Center. He was born September 24, 1916 in Davis County, Iowa to Charles Irvin and Nancy Maude Bartlett Hunt. He married Marie Linebaugh March 7, 1940 in Ottumwa, Iowa. Roy was a farmer and businessman.
