Rusty Gene Grinstead went home to be with the Lord on October 10, 2023 at the age of 67. He left behind a legacy of hard work, good will, and most of all, love shown to all of his family members and friends. He was born on June 2, 1956 to Dewey Grinstead, Jr. and Carol (Wilkinson) Grinstead near Floris. He graduated from Davis County High School in 1974. During high school, he was a member of the football, baseball, basketball, and track teams. Rusty was an excellent high jumper having qualified for the state meet and Drake Relays his junior and senior years, placing 6th at the state meet in 1973.

After graduation, Rusty worked as a carpenter building houses in Missouri and Iowa with his good friend Bob Lobbins. He became a master of his trade, helping to build over 100 homes. He put his vast knowledge to good use later in life as he was the ultimate Mr. Fix-it for his children well into their adulthood! When grandchildren came into Rusty's life, he loved spending as much time with them as possible and enjoyed going to all of their activities. Rusty had many talents and hobbies. He could build anything, and especially enjoyed woodworking. He was an avid deer hunter and bass fisherman. He also enjoyed coyote hunting with many of his friends from the Floris area and talking on the phone daily with Mike Boas. His favorite place to be was in his dream bass boat on a lake with his dog and beloved companion who went everywhere with him, Lucky.
