Steven Ray Steeples, also known to many as Peeeedro, passed away on the morning of November 10, 2021 in Bloomfield, Iowa after a battle with cancer. Peeeedro was 61. He was born in Des Moines, Iowa in 1960 and had been a resident of Bloomfield, Iowa for two years prior to his passing.

After that he "worked to afford to camp" as he put it. He would spend the majority of spring thru fall each year camping.

Peeeedro was preceded in death by his mother, Donna Mae and his older brother, Ronald Arthur.

He is survived by his son, Michael Jeffrey; father, Ronald Thomas; brothers, Thomas Allen (wife, Michael) Steeples, Charles Robert (wife, Kristyn) Steeples; and 16 nieces and nephews.
