Terry Jon Garmon, 53, of Bloomfield, Iowa passed away September 13, 2015 at the Davis County Hospital. He was born August 24, 1962 in Bloomfield to Dallas Laverne and Mary Joann Dabney Garmon. He graduated from Davis County High School in 1980 and from the Indian Hills Auto Body Program in 1982. After graduation he went to work at Boone Body Works in Bloomfield, then Vaughn Motors in Ottumwa, and for the past eleven years he has been employed by Kollision Korner in Bloomfield.

Terry lived his life to the fullest by spending time with his family and friends and entertaining them with his love of telling jokes and stories, dancing, and singing karaoke. Some of his favorite pastimes included riding his motorcycle, restoring cars, and collecting Elvis memorabilia.

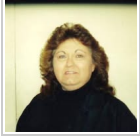

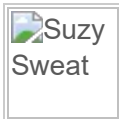
