DRAKESVILLE: Vaughn Leo Proctor, 97, of Drakesville, Iowa died April 1, 2013 at Davis County Hospital Long Term Care in Bloomfield, Iowa where he had resided for seven years and nine months. He was born March 31, 1916 in Marion Township, Davis County, Iowa to Elmer and Stella Bolin Proctor. He lived and farmed in Marion Township his lifetime, a farm which his grandfather, William Proctor, had farmed before him. Vaughn was an eighth grade graduate of Oak Springs School where he served as a school board member as an adult. He was a member of the county wide Baby Beef 4-H club in the 1930's. Vaughn also served as a township trustee and was a long-time member of the Davis County Farm Bureau. On April 22, 1939 he was united in marriage to Mabel Irene White. They were the parents of three children, JoElla Cossel of Bloomfield, Iowa, Max (Kay) Proctor of Drakesville, and Gene (Kathy) Proctor of Bargersville, Indiana. Mabel passed away August 20, 2004. He is survived by his children; his daughters-in-law; ten grandchildren; 30 great-grandchildren; and nine great-great-grandchildren. He loved people, especially the children, and remembered each grandchild and great-grandchild on their birthday for many years. He was preceded in death by his parents; five brothers, Victor, Dwight, Herschel, Dr. Lester, and Manscel Proctor; two sisters, Fae Leffler and Mae Archer; and a son-in-law, Loren Cossel. Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m. on Friday, April 5, 2013 at the Wagler Funeral Home in Bloomfield conducted by his grandson, Matt Proctor, President of Ozark Christian College in Joplin, Missouri. Interment will
