BLOOMFIELD: Verlin Edwin Spurgeon, 82, of Greeley, Colorado and former resident of Davis County, Iowa died June 19, 2010 at the Colorado State Home for Veterans in Aurora, Colorado. He was born April 25, 1928 in Davis County to Raymond and Delpha Spurgeon. He married Christine Y. Fleming August 5, 1949 at the Christian Church Parsonage in Bloomfield.
