



## Wilma Good

November 27, 1929 - January 11, 2024

Wilma Jean Good, 94, went to the Heavens to be with her loved ones January 11, 2024, at the Bloomfield Care Center in Bloomfield, Iowa.

Wilma was born to Raymond and Ruth Duley Wilfawn on November 27, 1929, in Moulton, Iowa. She and her parents along with brother Don, moved many times during WWII. Her father worked in ammo factories in several towns in Iowa. On July 20, 1946, she married Charles Good. She and Olive spent many days fishing at their ponds, antiquing, ditch digging, and mushroom hunting. More than anything, Wilma loved her grandkids. She spent 30 years waiting for them to get off the school bus. She and Charlie loved to dance in the early years.

Wilma and Charlie traveled to Fort Madison and Sidney to watch the rodeos until Bloomfield brought their rodeo to town. Then they spent countless hours helping Ed feed rodeo stock and cleaning the arena. Charlie and Wilma loved going to watch the grandkids perform in rodeo competitions and went to as many ball games as possible.

Memorial services will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, January 17, 2024 at the Wagler Funeral Home in Bloomfield with Rev. James Wakelin officiating. Her cremated remains will be scattered on the family farm at a later date. Visitation will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday with the family present to greet friends from 9:30 a.m. until the time of the service.
