Wilma R. Teubel, 95, of Bloomfield, Iowa entered her eternal rest on April 12, 2024. She was born February 7, 1929 to Elias and Lydia Schlupp Fischer on their Roanoke, Illinois farm. She was the sixth of nine children. Wilma was a 1947 graduate of Roanoke High School and worked at Interlocking Fence Company. She married Richard Teubel in Morton, Illinois in 1956 and became a farm wife. They raised their seven children on a dairy farm; working and making memories together.

Wilma was devoted to her faith, family, and farm life.
